IT'S GOOD FOR US

HOW SHOULD WE GIVE?

JOYFULLY

Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

God is the happiest, most cheerful, being in (or outside of) the universe! He's also the One who gives the most. The two are linked. And we cannot out-give God! One way or another, He'll bless us and pay us back. So, let's be joyful as we give!

SACRIFICIALLY

In contrast to the Old Testament commandment of a 10% tithe, the New Testament focuses more on our attitude than any amount. The widow's mite shows us that generosity is more about proportion of income given than just the size of our donation! The point is, giving should hurt. Imagine Everest is our giving, where Jesus is at the summit and base camp is 10%. It's great to reach base camp, but we are called to keep on climbing...

INTENTIONALLY

It's good to plan. God calls us to give from our 'first fruits' and not from what's left over. Setting up a monthly, quarterly or annual standing order can really help us get into good habits personally as well as help St. Peter's plan more effectively for the future.

RESPONSIBLY

LOOKING AHEAD

We can all see how much God has been doing at St. Peter's recently, but there is so much more we'd love to do! If the £121k deficit comes in, our plans are:

- Take on a a full-time associate vicar, to help Pat with services and increase our pastoral care.
- Employ a part-time women's worker who can specialise in ministry to women in our church.
- Employ a part-time social media manager, who can put out high quality content.
- Pay for a production engineer at church each Sunday to ensure the technology is used to its full capacity.

We have other hopes for the future as well:

- Employ a Community Outreach Worker to connect with the lonely, the least and the lost.
- Invest in our building. E.g. by replacing or reupholstering the chairs at some point, allowing people to sit comfortably during the sermons! (We could shorten the sermons, but that's harder...)

All of this costs money! Fundraising may be required. But we believe that if we all give what God is calling us to give, most of these needs would be met. And isn't it exciting to all play a part!

SO...

- If you have not started giving to St. Peter's, might you think about doing so?
- If you give by standing order, might you be able to increase your giving?
- If you do not plan your giving, might you consider doing so, or at least a portion of it?

Never think that your donation is too small to make a difference! Remember the widow's mite...

2023 FORECAST

INCOME PROJECTIONS

Based on income received in 2022, we have forecast the following levels of income during 2023:

Planned Giving (Monthly/Quarterly/Annually):	£151,000
Rental Income (Korean Church/Ad-hoc bookings):	£67,000
Other Income (Wedding & Funeral Fees/Concerts):	£2,000
TOTAL	£220,000

PROJECTED EXPENDITURE FOR 2023

Our total expenditure is forecast to be £341,000.



This leaves a potential deficit of £121,000. However, we are confident that if we each give biblically, this need will be comfortably met. After all, if we assume a core membership of 120 and the London average income of £36,000 a year, our planned giving alone would be £432,000. As a church we commit to this principle by giving away 10% of what we receive.

And if we saw such giving, just imagine what that would enable us to do...

HOW CAN WE GIVE?

BANK TRANSFER

The most helpful way is to give by Bank Transfer – ideally setting up a regular standing order. This means we do not have to pay any fees and St Peter's receive the full value of your donation.
